

16 - 19 Bursary Application Form (2025-26)

The 16-19 Bursary Fund at Durham Sixth Form Centre is a means-tested financial support program available to students up to the age of 19. Designed to help overcome financial barriers to education, the bursary provides direct payments into students' bank accounts, ensuring they have the necessary support to continue their studies.

We may request additional information from students, this will be done via the student's school email address. Students will be informed in writing once eligibility for a bursary has been established.

Bursary payments are only made if attendance and behaviour meet the required standard and students remain at Durham Sixth Form Centre. If attendance falls below 90% payments may be reduced.
